Aims and Objectives:

- To build leadership skills and confidence.
- To assist young people to become effective leaders in their communities.
- To build positive links between the police and young people.
- Accreditation with UCAS points. The UCAS Tariff is the system for allocating points to qualifications used for entry to higher education. It allows students to use a range of different qualifications to help secure a place on an undergraduate course.

Target audience for course is 16-18 yr old students from BRM (Black or Racial Minority) background or any students who have had to overcome significant barriers in their life.

There are 20 places available for the course.
